Every case today has a digital footprint. This three-day course gives new investigators and prosecutors the foundation to find, preserve, and use it. It gives seasoned practitioners an updated framework for the major sources of evidence they encounter daily. You'll work through cellphones and cell site location information, IoT devices, OSINT, and cryptocurrency, learning the legal process, acquisition, and analysis behind each, then apply it hands-on: writing search warrant affidavits and analyzing the data they return. You'll also sharpen the skills that carry a case forward, from tactical interviewing to presenting digital evidence in court.
